### Summer School Registration Procedures

- Brockton Public Schools students must have a Summer School Course Selection Form signed by their guidance counselor in order to register.
- All students MUST register during the scheduled registration periods in the Green Café or at the Guidance Office at Brockton High School.
- Tuition must be **paid in full** at the time of registration, either in cash, check, credit card or by money order; there are no payment plans. Consult the calendar as well as the Tuition Schedule for late registration information. Checks and credit card payments will be accepted with proper identification. Money orders should be made payable to Brockton Community Schools.
- Tuition is refunded only if a class is cancelled for low enrollment.
